Welcome and Introduction - Prayer	You could either introduce the Band of Hope and do a bit of teaching about the background, or immediately get into role and welcome the children to the meeting as Victorian children, reminding them how to behave and telling them what to expect in the meeting

Magic Lantern Show – A Temperance Tale OR John Tregonoweth - his Mark – there is no quiz for this one as the video is longer	Show the video – an example of a magic lantern show that would have been shown to children in the Victorian era. (Tell the group you will be doing a short quiz afterwards to see what they learnt.)
